Pharm Sem VII and M Pharm Sem I (Pharmaceutics) at Ratnamani Healthcare, 750/1, Village-Indrad, Nr. Chhatral, G.I.D.C, Ahmedabad-Mehsana Highway, Ta. Kadi, Dist. Mehsana-382721.

The visit was scheduled from campus to the Ratnamani Healthcare and back. Campus has arranged transportation facility to students. Students and Faculty members (Dr. B. G. Prajapati and Dr. Nikunjana Patel) left for Chhatral at around 11.00 am from the college and reached there at around 11.45am.

The visit started with the HR department of the company. Students gathered information about the growth of the company and its status in market and their future plan in business. They have visited different departments and sections of industry like QA, QC, F&D, production department etc. where the production of solid as well as liquid dosage form was undergoing. The company have been approved by WHO & GMP guidelines for the manufacturing of oral and injectable pharmaceutical preparations. They were allowed to observe and explained the working principles of various instruments and products. Company has allotted one technical expert to guide the students. Accompanied Faculty members have also explained the use and importance of various instruments. This helps them to understand the mechanism which they had studied in theory classes for last 6 semesters. At the end, one last session was organised by the company especially for students to clear their doubts regarding any process. Their technical staffs were very supportive and eager to give the answers of all questions asked by the students. Students have asked some questions to them about their products, equipment's, marketing strategy, etc. Students came back from Ratnamani Healthcare to college at about 4.00pm.

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**REPORT on INDUSTRIAL VISIT at PRAMUKH PHARMACHEM**

DATE:-07/09/2018

An industrial visit of B. Pharm. Sem. VII and M. Pharm. Sem. I (Quality Assurance) student was arranged by SKPCPER at Pramukh Pharmachem, a small scale API manufacturing company. on 7th Sept. 2018. Total 40 students along with two faculty members, Dr. Dipti Patel and Ms. Bhoomi Patel, participated in this visit. The company is associated with API and intermediates manufacturing having GMP approved plant. Students had seen manufacturing facilities including all departments as per GMP requirement and during visit manufacturing of Nicorandil was going on.

As Company is newly established and having are various departments like:

- Raw material/Packing material store
- Manufacturing area
- Filtration room
- Pulverization room
- Quarantine room
- Packaging area
- Finished product area
- Retain sample room
- R & D Laboratory
- Physicochemical Laboratory

In manufacturing area they have installed two reactors of 200 liter and one 20 liter capacity.

Currently they are producing two APIs

- Nicorandil IP/BP
- Sodium stearyl fumarate IP/BP/USP

Students get idea about implementation of theoretical aspects to practical in way of earning money and to implement theoretical steps to produce new molecule at laboratory scale and then commercial scale.

They also gathered a lot of information about working manners in pharmaceutical industry and How to synthesize good quality product. Also, students are very curious, so they have asked so many questions about Pharmaceutical practices and how to start up own business in terms of initial planning, fund management and how to implement small idea into commercial base.
