

REPORT ON INDUSTRIAL VISIT

On 5th October 2017 the students of S.K.Patel College Of Pharmaceutical Education And Research Institute, Ganpat University, Kherva of B-Pharm Semester-III were taken to an industrial visit.

Seventy five students participated to the industrial visit. The industrial visit was co-ordinated by Dr. Geeta.M.Patel and Dr. Arun.M.Prajapati.

Royal Castor Product Ltd.

Students have visited “Royal Castor Product Ltd.” at 11:45 A.M. During visit they have visited different processing area of the industry.

The company is engaged in production of derivatives of castor oil and export there products to Japanese and German companies. During the visit of processing units, students have visited various areas like Bleaching area, Saturation area, QA department, Packaging department, Warehouses, Research and Development department.

In the saturation department students have seen the process of conversion of unsaturated castor oil to saturated one and transforming the saturated oil to flakes by solidification. In QA department students were introduced to various analysis process of intermediate and final products. In packaging area various packaging of different derivative products was shown to students. At R & D department industry do research works for the material used in road constructions, etc. The derivatives products of this company are used in cosmetic products, laxative preparation, pharmaceutical products, etc.

The in-charge on duty of various departments delivered good knowledge of process and machinery in plant to the students.

Then students left the plant by 2:00 P.M.

Unjha Formulations

In this industry there were two divisions were seen by students.

One Allopathic department in which the company is engaged in manufacturing capsules and tablet formulations.

Another Ayurvedic department in which the company is engaged in manufacturing flavoured Isapgul powder formulation.

During visit to processing units, students have visited Mixing and Processing area, QA department, Packaging area and warehouse area of the company. In mixing and processing area they do mixing of various drug and excipients and produce the product. There students have seen various instruments like double con blender, tablet punching machines, etc. In

packaging area, various different packaging of tablets, capsules, and powders was shown to the students.

Students left the industry at 3:00 P.M. and reached to college at 3:45 P.M.
